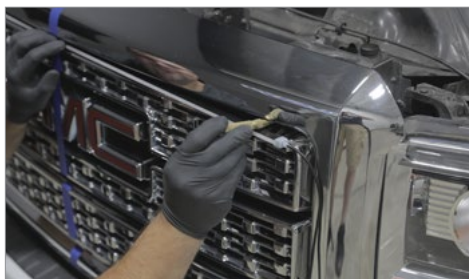
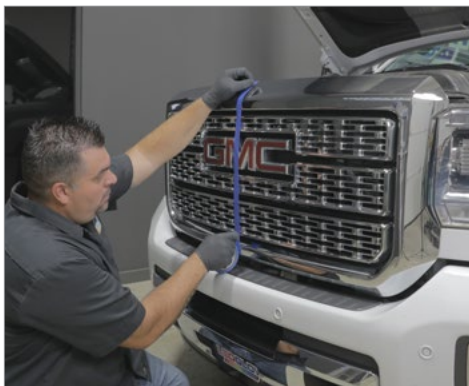
REMOVE COMPONENTS TO GAIN ACCESS:

1. Open the hood and take out the 12 push-pin clips to remove the cover.



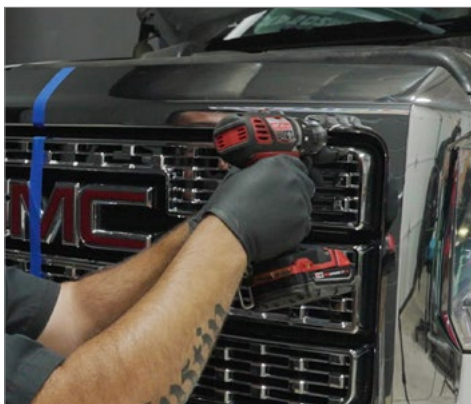
ALIGN THE BARS:

2. Using painter's tape, mark the center of the grille from the top to the bottom.
3. Measure and mark each bar in the center with painter's tape.
4. Align the tape on the bars to the grill and mark the (4) upper bar studs as well as the (2) lower bar studs which are located at a solid location of the grille using a center punch or paint pen.

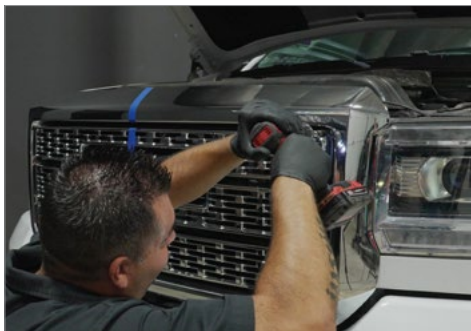


PREPARE TO MOUNT THE BARS:

5. **Optional:** You can remove the grille from the truck, but it is not necessary. Remove the (4) 10mm bolts on the top of the grille and gently pull on the grille to release the spring clips along the bottom and in the center of the grille.
6. Using a 9/64ths drill bit, drill the (6) holes for the studs.



7. With the upper and lower bars in place, locate and mark the location for the wire to pass through the grille.
8. With the harness out of the way, use a step bit to drill a 3/8ths hole. If a step bit is not available, you can countersink the hole location to prevent walking and then drill with a 3/8ths drill bit.



Note: Be sure to remove the tape from the bar and the grille.

9. Using a 6mm wrench, ensure that all of the mounting studs are tight on both bars.
10. Using the supplied brackets and nuts, secure the grille lights to the grille using a 5.5mm socket.

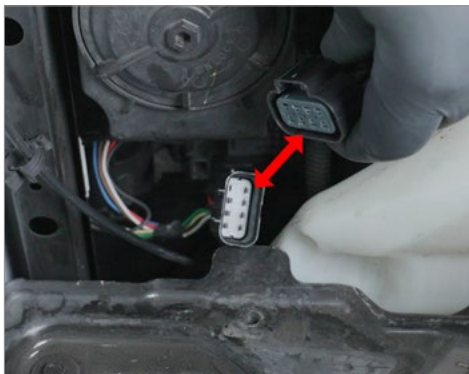


CONNECTING TO POWER:

11. Remove the driver's side fender brace using a 10mm socket.



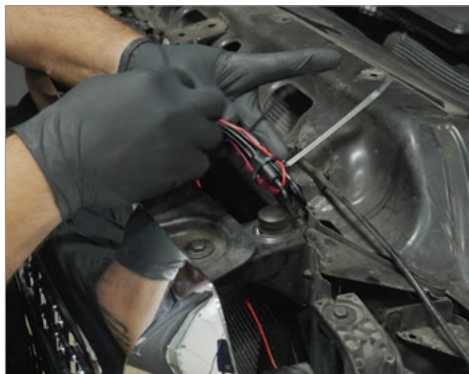
12. Remove the driver's side battery from the vehicle.
13. Locate and unplug the connector on the back of the driver's side headlight.



14. Plug the pass-through harness into the back of the driver's side headlight.
15. Plug the factory harness into the pass-through harness



16. Route the wires from the pass-through harness behind the grille and plug in the grille light splitter harness.
17. Plug the (2) grille lights into the splitter harness.
18. Be sure to secure any loose harness with zip ties away from the heat of the radiator.

**REASSEMBLY:**

19. Clip the grille back into place and reinstall the (4) bolts if the grille was removed.
20. Reinstall the battery and the fender brace.
21. Reinstall the cover and the (12) push-pin clips.

TEST THE INSTALLATION:

22. Turn on the headlights to ensure everything is working correctly.
